





The tools we make are conceived and constructed with an eye for simplicity, durability, and efficiency. For Petzl, being a pioneer has meant 50 years of passion, expertise, innovation, and continuous improvement. This approach to our craft and our business has allowed us to serve as a global expert, as we did in 2006 with the conception of the EXO personal escape system. At the request of, and in collaboration with, the firefighters of New York City, we were able to design an efficient solution that would allow easy escape in critical situations. It's an achievement that has been recognized with several awards, including best invention of the year by Time Magazine.

3. Industrial Excellence





Beyond the Standards

We have a deep responsibility to the people who trust us with their lives, and we develop, test, and qualify all of our products above required standards. Our design center, based in France, integrates all crafts that are related to the creation of products: mechanical, textile, electronic, optical, and technological. From the design and prototype phases, the reliability of a product and the safety of the user are continuously evaluated, with particular attention to risks of use.

With labs dedicated to product testing, we conduct dynamic fall and impact resistance tests, perform cyclical testing, and evaluate performance, as well as beam quality and burn times of our headlamps. This process includes rigorous field testing in order to test the ergonomics and reliability during real-world use.





Zero Defects - PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

Reliability is at the center of our concerns: our goal is for our products to consistently function at the same level of excellence. Our objective is to allow zero defective products to leave our facilities, which involves processes with significant extra costs at every stage of production.

As we navigate an increasingly globalized economy, we go to great lengths to support our distributors and dealers, and we are heavily involved in the fight against counterfeit products.

Production and Inspection

Petzl's production sites are located in France, in the towns of Crolles, Eybens, and Rotherens, as well as in Rawang, Malaysia. Remaining competitive and keeping the majority of our production in France means that we continuously optimize our production lines and reduce our waste. This production infrastructure is complemented by long-term partnerships with key suppliers in Europe and Asia.

Our purchasing and quality control teams work closely with suppliers, ensuring to the best of our abilities, product reliability and quality that meets or exceeds our strict requirements. Quality inspection is present throughout every step of the production process: machine inspection of operations, human inspection at key points, further reinforcement by errorproofing systems and final individual inspection of each product.

We regularly audit the methods, quality management systems, and CSR practices (Corporate Social Responsibility) of our suppliers and strategic partners, especially when it comes to their employees.

We produce high-quality technical content that is available to everyone and utilized by the different communities that we serve. Petzl harnesses are designed to meet the needs of all those who play in the vertical world, whether it's for climbing, mountaineering, via ferrata, canyoning, or caving. We offer a variety of models suited for different body types and different uses.



Designs for multiple body types:

- Harnesses WITH adjustable leg loops, suitable for most body types and all seasons (winter and summer use).
- Harnesses WITHOUT adjustable leg loops, making it lightweight and optimizing freedom of movement.
- Women's harnesses with angled waistbelt and an adapted rise and waistbelt-to-leg-loop ratio.

Capacity to carry gear suited to the activity:

- For gym climbing, via ferrata, glacier travel, or classic mountaineering, two gear loops are sufficient.
- For single pitch or big wall climbing, four gear loops are necessary.
- For activities requiring a lot of gear, such as trad climbing, technical mountaineering, or ice climbing, a fifth gear loop is more practical.




Petzl Hamess Technology

For certain climbing and mountaineering harnesses, Petzl uses specific technologies: FRAME, ENDOFRAME, FUSEFRAME or WIREFRAME. These constructions, which never sacrifice climber comfort, are adapted to different expectations that climbers may have, whether you're just starting out, an active climber, or looking for high performance.



FRAME Technology


This construction forms the core of CORAX and OUISTITI harnesses and combines a thick layer of foam with central webbing on the waistbelt and leg loops. The load is distributed by the webbing that is surrounded by foam. This construction allows for great durability and comfort when hanging for long periods on a climb.



ENDOFRAME Technology



This construction method uses thin foam and specific variable-width webbing sewn onto the foam for optimal load distribution. The waistbelt webbing is wider at the hips, providing support while remaining lightweight. We've paid careful attention to providing maximum comfort and greatly reduce pressure points or hot spots on the waistbelt. ENDOFRAME technology is used in SAMA, SELENA, ADJAMA, LUNA, and MACCHU harnesses.







This construction gives the harness an exceptional weight-to-comfort ratio that makes it practically unnoticeable when worn. WIREFRAME technology, applied to a very sleek design with very slim technical lines, is perfectly suited to high-performance SITTA and ALTITUDE harnesses.



What are the different requirements for a ski touring helmet?


Ventilation:

In ski touring, the physical effort generated on the climb is considerable and requires appropriate gear. Only a lightweight, and most importantly, ventilated helmet can be comfortably worn from beginning to end of an outing.

Head Protection:

Throughout a ski touring day, climbing or descending, the skier may face any of the following risks:

- Rockfall:



As in mountaineering, the skier may be exposed to rock or icefall, for example when climbing a couloir.

- Side, front, and rear impacts:



A fall while climbing on a steep or frozen slope above a rocky outcrop.



A fall while descending caused by terrain hazards: rocks, trees, ice blocks, crevasses, avalanches, or other possible hazards.

The best balance of ventilation and protection for the head will encourage participants to wear a helmet from beginning to end of an outing.

Why has Petzl pursued the creation of a new CE certification for ski touring helmets?

Currently there is no reference standard outlining the health and safety requirements for a ski touring helmet, unlike downhill skiing, which follows the guidelines of the EN 1077 class B standard.

Therefore, in order to obtain CE certification for a helmet used for ski touring, Petzl approached a certified body to create a standard that takes into consideration the practice, the environment, and the dangers of ski touring. This reference standard is based primarily on:

- The requirements of the mountaineering helmet standard (EN 12492), to provide rockfall protection, as well as maximum ventilation for comfort during ascents.
- Requirements for enhanced protection against lateral, front, and rear impacts (as described in the Petzl test protocol for the TOP AND SIDE PROTECTION label).

This new reference standard is the PCSR-001 (Protocol for ski touring helmets). It is public and available to other manufacturers for certification of their helmets.








Hand Positioning

This hand position is valid regardless of the device used.


Your hand must never let go of the brake side of the rope.



Giving Slack

To give slack, your brake-side hand pushes the rope towards the device, creating slack; your other hand pulls the rope through the device.

To repeat this movement, slide your brakeside hand along the rope, without ever letting it go.



Taking up Slack

To take up slack, pull in the climber side of the rope and pull the brake side of the rope through the device. Never let go of the brake side of the rope.

Even though this hand sequence is common to all belay systems, the position and the tightness of the grip of the brake-side hand are determined by the function and performance of the belay device. These two features also affect the comfort of the belay.

Petzl Belay Systems: Two Types of Devices

Belay Devices with Cam-Assisted Blocking

Working Principle



When a climber falls or rests, the rope tightens and the cam pivots to pinch the rope and block it.

- Advantages
- Comfortable belay with cam-assisted blocking, which minimizes the strength required of the brake-side hand and is especially useful for working a route: trying a move multiple times and holding the climber
- Considerable leeway for brake-side hand position, regardless of the angle between the climber-side and brake-side ropes
- **Exceptionally comfortable descent**, due to the ergonomic handle that controls the progressive rope feed

When a climber falls or rests, the brake hand grips the rope firmly and pulls it downward, the rope gets pressed into the braking grooves, thus increasing the friction until the rope stops.





Types of Ropes



Dynamic Ropes

Single Ropes ①

Ropes used as a single strand. These are mainly used for single-pitch climbing. Some climbers also use them for multi-pitch climbing or mountaineering.

Half 1/2 and Twin (10) Ropes

These are certified to two types of the CE EN 892 standard.

- Half Ropes: ropes used in pairs that may be clipped separately or together during progression. They are recommended for rappels and to facilitate rope drag management. They provide a backup in case one of the strands is damaged by a falling rock or a sharp edge.
- Twin Ropes: ropes used in pairs that, unlike half ropes, must always be clipped together during progression. They are recommended for rappels.

Multi-Type Ropes

Multi-type ropes are certified to three types of the CE EN 892 standard. They may be used as a single, half, or twin rope.

Low Stretch Kernmantle Ropes

Low stretch kernmantle ropes have low elongation and are very resistant to abrasion. They are designed for caving, canyoning, rope ascent, or hauling, as well as for route development.

UIAA Guide Dry Treatment

The UIAA Guide Dry treatment is our most complete water repellent treatment for frequent use in wet environments. It makes a difference especially for regular use in extreme environments: ice climbing, mountaineering. This treatment also improves the rope's resistance to dirt and abrasion.

The UIAA Guide Dry treatment meets the requirements of the UIAA Water Repellent test. The results of this test indicate water absorption of less than 2%.

The manufacturing process for UIAA Guide Dry treatment has two stages: the core is treated before the rope is braided and then the entire rope is treated in order to minimize water absorption and penetration of fine particles into the rope.



Duratec Dry Treatment

Dry treatment making the rope more resistant to water, dirt, and abrasion. Handling, grip, and other characteristics are retained longer in cold, wet conditions.



EverFlex Treatment

Special treatment stabilizes the core strands and improves consistency. Provides excellent grip and consistent handling over time.



UltraSonic Finish

Ultrasonic welding bonds the core and sheath together at the rope ends. Gives greater durability and helps avoid frayed ends.



ClimbReady Coil

Special coil makes the rope ready to use. Helps avoid initial uncoiling mistakes and increases longevity.



Middle Mark

Indicates the middle of the rope for easier rope management.

Ice Axe Use and Standards

The line of Petzl ice axes is composed of different families:

- Ice axes for glacier travel and ski mountaineering
- Classic mountaineering ice axes
- Technical mountaineering ice axes
- Ice axes for ice climbing and dry tooling

Each one of these ice axes has characteristics specific to its use on the terrain, such as the length, shape of the shaft, and shape of the pick.


Standards

In terms of standards, ice axes are divided into two types: Type 1 and Type 2. These types make a distinction between basic and technical ice axes.

This distinction is made using different tests:

- Shaft center-load pull test
- Shaft insertion strength test
- Pick levering test

These tests are detailed in the diagrams here.




Pull Test

Type 1 Ice Axes

These ice axes have a lower strength requirement than Type 2 ice axes. They are generally used for skiing, glacier travel, and classic mountaineering. For Type 1 ice axes, no marking is required, but if there is any, the marking is: B.


Type 2 Ice Axes

These ice axes have the highest strength required by the standard. They are primarily used for technical mountaineering, ice climbing, and dry tooling. For Type 2 ice axes, markings are required. The marking is: T.

Petzl ascenders are designed for ascending fixed ropes, but they also have other uses including helping a second in difficulty, hauling a victim out of a crevasse or up a wall or self-belaying. For this, there are several types of ascenders: hand ascenders, chest ascenders and backup ascenders.

Because of their excellent handling, these ascenders are mainly used for ascending ropes. Their design also provides various ways to install the device on a rope to make a pulley system or haul a pack.









Lighting performance as defined by the ANSI/PLATO FL 1 protocol

Petzl has chosen to comply with the ANSI (American National Standards Institute) FL 1 protocol to measure and demonstrate the lighting performance and burn times of our headlamps. This voluntary move allows users to easily compare the lighting performance and burn times of different headlamp models using standardized criteria.

Lighting Performance: How Is It Measured?



• Brightness (lumens)

This measurement is taken between 30 and 120 seconds after the headlamp is turned on. It indicates the maximum light output when the lamp is first turned on using new batteries (included).



• Lighting distance (meters)

This is the maximum distance between the lamp and the location where only 0.25 lux of illumination remains. The measurement is taken when the lamp is turned on, using new batteries. Lighting distance depends directly on brightness, but mainly on the shape of the beam.




• Burn time (hours)

This corresponds to the length of time during which lighting is optimal. It is measured 30 seconds after the lamp is turned on and for as long as the lamp takes to drop to 10 % of maximum light output.



Reserve lighting (outside scope of ANSI/PLATO FL 1 protocol)

In addition to these measures, Petzl provides reserve lighting. Reserve lighting provides minimum light level for walking. However, the light may not be sufficient for fast-paced activities (such as running, mountain biking, or skiing).

Watertightness in conformity with IEC standard: What do the IP ratings on Petzl headlamps mean?

A headlamp's resistance to solids and/or liquids is indicated by its IP rating. This index classifies the level of protection offered by equipment against intrusions by solids (e.g. dust) and liquids (e.g. water, oil).



Rating complies with the majority of headlamp uses, in rain, snow, or humidity. All Petzl headlamps are at least IPX4 rated (weather resistant).



Rating indicates the headlamp is waterproof to in up to 1 meter of fresh water for 30 minutes. The e+LITE headlamp is IPX7 rated.





Rope access work often involves environments at significant height. Work done in confined spaces entails challenges related to the lack of space and lack of means of autonomous progression.



Tree Care

Not all tree work can be done using exterior means such as elevated platforms or ladders. In this case, to move and work, the arborist uses rope progression techniques.



Framing and Roofing

In this type of work situation, the risk of slipping and falling is higher. A fall-arrest system must therefore be installed to guard against these hazards.






Self-Rescue

A firefighter who finds himself or herself trapped inside a burning structure must be prepared for self-evacuation and have the appropriate equipment on hand.



Hazardous Areas

Where there is risk of explosion, the hazardous locations are classified by zone (ATEX and/or HAZLOC). All of the materials used must therefore conform with current regulations for this type of zone.





Maintenance and Workshops

Professionals working at concerts and shows, in workshops, in maintenance, or in the energy and networks sector all require practical and lightweight headlamps on a daily basis.

New Knowledge to Better Prepare for an Ascent of Mont Blanc

Financed by the Petzl Foundation, a new study has improved our understanding of the origin of rockfall in the Goûter couloir on the Mont Blanc normal route. The study offers important information to help us better prepare to ascend the highest peak in the Alps, which has been made available in a video distributed on various platforms.

The Goûter couloir on the normal route of Mont Blanc is one of the most accident-prone passages in the Alps, with an average of 3 fatalities and 8 injuries per season. In order to better identify geomorphological and meteorological phenomena causing rockfall and evaluate risk for mountaineers, geographer Jacques Mourey mobilized a team of a dozen researchers from the Université Savoie Mont-Blanc and the Université Grenoble-Alpes. They set up a traffic sensor to document the number, time, and direction of passing mountaineers, a digital camera to study the evolution of the snowpack in the couloir, and seismic sensors to detect rockfall and measure its intensity.

In order to make the information available to as many people as possible, we have produced a video that has received over 500,000 views on social media platforms. This educational film depicts the dangerous reality of traversing the couloir and the Goûter ridge in order to inform the public, who may not always take into consideration how technical and exposed it is.

Intended to spark discussion around finding solutions to reduce the risks of this difficult problem in mountaineering, this video received numerous comments that we have supplemented by distributing a survey to close to two hundred key actors in the mountaineering community, in France and abroad.

The results of this investigation will be published summer 2021.


